**4. Title:** Nuclear energy; strategic plan.

**5. Summary:** Directs the Department of Mines, Minerals and Energy, the Secretary of Commerce and Trade, and the Secretary of Education to work in coordination with the Virginia Nuclear Energy Consortium Authority and the Virginia Economic Development Partnership Authority to develop a strategic plan for the role of nuclear energy in the Commonwealth's overall strategy for moving toward renewable and carbon-free energy. The plan shall be completed by October 1, 2020, and updated every four years thereafter.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Preliminary. See Item 8.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** It is anticipated that the fiscal impact of this bill on the Department of Mines, Minerals and Energy, the Secretaries of Commerce and Trade and Education, and the Virginia Economic Development Partnership Authority can be absorbed within existing resources.
