4. Title: Licensure exemption for student practice of veterinary medicine and veterinary technology.

5. Summary: Provides for (i) the issuance of a temporary postgraduate license to practice veterinary medicine to individuals participating in a veterinary residency or internship in a veterinary medical education program and (ii) an exemption from licensure for the practice of veterinary medicine and veterinary technology for qualified students completing a veterinary medicine or veterinary technology externship or preceptorship.
