3. Committee: Education

4. Title: Public institutions of higher education; in-state tuition; volunteer firefighters.

5. Summary: Declares eligible for in-state tuition charges regardless of domicile any individual who volunteers as a firefighter or an emergency medical services provider in the Commonwealth and has earned the minimum activity points to be eligible for a length of service award pursuant to a length of service award program.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill could allow for certain students to become eligible for in-state tuition who currently pay the out-of-state rate, and would constitute a loss of revenue equal to the difference between the two for institutions where such students are enrolled. The number of students who would be affected is indeterminate.
