- 3. Committee: Education
- 4. Title: Minimum staffing ratio for school counselors.
- **5. Summary:** Changes the effective date from school year 2019-2020 to school year 2020-2021 for the staffing standard that requires local school boards to employ school counselors in accordance with the following ratios, effective with the 2020-2021 school year: in elementary schools, one hour per day per 75 students, one full-time equivalent at 375 students, one hour per day additional time per 75 students or major fraction thereof; in middle schools, one period per 65 students, one full-time equivalent at 325 students, one additional period per 65 students or major fraction thereof; and in high schools, one period per 60 students, one full-time equivalent at 300 students, one additional period per 60 students to employ one full-time equivalent school year, the bill requires local school boards to employ one full-time equivalent school counselor position per 250 students in grades kindergarten through 12.

Fiscal Implications: HB 30, 2020 General Assembly Session, includes \$21.2 million in FY 2021 and \$78.1 million in FY 2022 to support the state share of cost for the additional school counselors required by this bill in school year 2020-2021 and 2021-2022. As such, a budget amendment is not necessary to support this legislation.
