3. Committee: Transportation

4. Title: Department of Transportation; primary evacuation routes.

5. Summary: Directs the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT), in consultation with the Department of Emergency Management, to develop, maintain, and make publicly available a map of primary evacuation routes in the Commonwealth. The bill requires VDOT to review the transportation infrastructure along such routes and submit a report with such findings and any recommended improvements to the General Assembly at least once every five years.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: The number of primary evacuation routes throughout the Commonwealth is currently unknown. As a result, the costs to VDOT associated with developing and publishing a map, reviewing infrastructure along the routes, and reporting on findings and recommendations are indeterminate. Any such costs would require VDOT to move resources from other priorities within its budget.

This legislation is not anticipated to have a fiscal impact to the Department of Emergency Management.
