Certain large general service customers are exempt from the costs of certain energy efficiency programs. The measure requires the State Corporation Commission to allow a large general service customer to not participate in energy efficiency programs if such customer has implemented energy efficiency programs that have produced or will produce measured and verified results consistent with industry standards and other regulatory criteria. The measure requires the Commission to adopt regulations requiring exempted customers to certify that its energy efficiency programs have delivered measured and verified savings within the prior five years.
