5.	<b>Summary:</b> This bill authorizes the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries to charge a fee for the use of any facility that the Department manages and any boat ramp that the Department owns or manages. Current law authorizes such fee only for a facility that is owned by the Department. The bill adds exemptions from such fees for a person holding a valid access permit issued by the Department and any person who is a passenger in but not the owner or operator of a paddlecraft or registered vessel. The bill includes technical changes.

8.	<b>Fiscal Implications:</b> The fiscal impact of this bill is indeterminate, as the number of boat ramp users that would be required to purchase a license, access permit or boat registration is unknown.
