**5. Summary:** Exempts the officers and employees of the Fort Monroe Authority from the provisions and requirements of the Virginia Personnel Act.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** It is anticipated that this bill will not result in a fiscal impact to the Fort Monroe Authority (FMA). FMA has been advised by the Office of the Attorney General and the Department of Human Resource Management that FMA employees are not classified state employees and are exempt from the Virginia Personnel Act. This bill clarifies the issue.
