4. Title: Special license plate bearing the legend STOP GUN VIOLENCE; revenue-sharing provisions.

5. Summary: This bill provides that the special license plate bearing the legend STOP GUN VIOLENCE will remain non-revenue sharing. Current law provides that such special license plate will become revenue sharing on July 1, 2020.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item #8.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is anticipated that this legislation will have no fiscal impact. At the time of passage in 2018, STOP GUN VIOLENCE was a non-revenue sharing plate with enactment provisions set to convert the plate into a revenue sharing license plate on July 1, 2020. This bill would repeal the enactment provisions, thus leaving the specialty plate an awareness plate with the standard \$10 fee.
