- 5. Summary: Increases from \$1 to \$3 the fee for open-space preservation charged for every deed, deed of trust, contract, or other instrument admitted to record in those jurisdictions in which open-space easements are held by the Virginia Outdoors Foundation. The bill also clarifies that the fee applies to any "deed of trust, contract, or other instrument" admitted to record, by adding to the term "deed."

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill increases the fee for open-space preservation charged for every deed, deed of trust, contract, or other instrument admitted to record in those jurisdictions in which open-space easements are held by the Virginia Outdoors Foundation from one dollar to three dollars. The Department of Taxation estimates that the increase in the fee charge will result in an additional \$1.9 million in revenue. Statute requires that this revenue be deposited to the Open-Space Lands Preservation Fund. The Department of

Conservation and Recreation will require a nongeneral fund appropriation to distribute this additional revenue to the Virginia Outdoors Foundation.
