4. Title: Capitol Police; concurrent jurisdiction.

5. Summary: The bill provides that a Capitol Police officer who is a detector canine handler has concurrent jurisdiction with the law-enforcement officers of any city or county that has requested the assistance of the Capitol Police in the detection of firearms, ammunition, explosives, propellants, or incendiaries.
