3. Committee: Agriculture, Conservation and Natural Resources

4. Title: Coal ash ponds; drinking water well; resident notification.

5. Summary: Requires the owner or operator of any coal ash pond located in the Chesapeake Bay watershed at the Bremo Power Station in Fluvanna County, Chesapeake Energy Center in the City of Chesapeake, Chesterfield Power Station in Chesterfield County, or Possum Point Power Station in Prince William County to complete a survey of all private and public water wells within one and a half miles of each of its ponds by October 1, 2020, and notify residents via mail and at least one newspaper of general circulation in the locality.
