**4. Title:** Online Virginia Network Authority; James Madison University.

**5. Summary:** Adds the President of James Madison University or his designee and one nonlegislative citizen member appointed by James Madison University to the members of the board of trustees of the Online Virginia Network Authority. The bill also adds James Madison University to the institutions of higher education for which the Online Virginia Network, established by the Authority, will facilitate the completion of degrees.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** Nonlegislative citizen members of the board are compensated as provided in § 2.2-2813, Code of Virginia, and all members are reimbursed for expenses incurred in the performance of their duties (travel, lodging, meals) as provided in §§2.2-2813 and 2.2-2825, Code of Virginia. Adding members to the board would therefore impose a small cost on the Authority, depending on how many meetings the board has in any given year. Any costs to James Madison to support the Authority are indeterminate at this time.
