3. Committee: Public Safety

4. Title: Concealed handgun permits; demonstration of competence.

5. Summary: Requires concealed handgun permit applicants to demonstrate competence with a handgun by completing an in-person course with a state-certified firearms instructor. Under current law, applicants may complete an electronic, video or online course to demonstrate competence. The bill also removes a provision providing that applicants may meet the training requirements by completing any National Rifle Association firearms safety or training course.

8. Fiscal Implications: The proposed legislation removes the option for concealed handgun permit applicants to demonstrate competence with a handgun by completing an electronic, video, or online course. It also removes a provision allowing applicants to complete the training requirements by completing a National Rifle Association firearms safety or training course. There is no anticipated fiscal impact on any state agency as a result of the provisions of this bill.
