- 4. Title: Va. Indoor Clean Air Act; prohibitions on smoking in satellite facilities
- **5. Summary:** The proposed legislation adds satellite facilities to the list of places where smoking is prohibited.
- 6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No

7. Minimal Fiscal Impact

- 8. Fiscal Implications: This proposal would expand the settings where smoking is prohibited and where violation of this prohibition would be subject to a \$25 civil penalty. All penalties collected as a result of smoking violations are deposited into the Virginia Health Care Fund and must be used as state match for Virginia's Medicaid program. In FY 2019, all existing smoking-related civil penalties generated \$1,107 in revenue for the Health Care Fund. As such, expanding prohibited settings as included in this proposal is not expected to have a significant impact on revenue collections or the Virginia Health Care Fund.
