**3. Committee:** Passed both Houses.

**4. Title:** Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services; industrial hemp industry working group; report.

**5. Summary:** Requires the Virginia Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services (VDACS) to convene a working group to assess the opportunities for development and manufacturing in the industrial hemp industry. The working group shall consist of the chief executive of the Virginia Economic Development Partnership or his designee, the members of the Tobacco Region Revitalization Commission appointed pursuant to Chapter 31 (§ 3.2-3100 et seq.) of Title 3.2 of the Code of Virginia, representatives of the Virginia Agribusiness Council and the Virginia Farm Bureau, and the Chief Workforce Development Advisor appointed pursuant to § 2.2-435.6 of the Code of Virginia. VDACS shall report by November 30, 2020, to the Chairmen of the House Committee on Agriculture, Chesapeake and Natural Resources and the Senate Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Natural Resources on the analysis of the working group.
