3. Committee: Courts of Justice

4. Title: Prohibition against participation in games of chance; exception for private clubs.

5. Summary: Creates an exception to the general prohibition against participation in games of chance for games that are conducted in private clubs, provided such private clubs are not commonly used for games of chance and there is no operator of such games.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Virginia Racing Commission anticipates that there may be an impact on the Historical Horse Racing wagering in Virginia as a result of this bill that is minimal and indeterminate at this time.
