4. Title: Legal holidays; Indigenous Peoples Day.

5. Summary: Removes official state observation of Columbus Day and replaces it with observation of Indigenous Peoples Day, honoring the historic, cultural, and contemporary significance of indigenous peoples.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: None.

8. Fiscal Implications: The proposed legislation is not expected to have a state fiscal impact, as the number of authorized state holidays would remain the same. The bill would rename the legal holiday observed on the second Monday in October.
