3. Committee: Education

4. Title: Public institutions of higher education; governing boards; educational programs.

5. Summary: Requires all members of governing boards of public institutions of higher education to participate in educational programs designed to address the role, duties, and responsibilities of the governing boards at least once within the first two years of membership and at least once within every two years of membership thereafter. Under current law, new members are required to participate in such programs at least once during their first two years of membership. The bill requires each public institution of higher education to maintain on its website the names of all voting members of the governing board who successfully complete such educational programs, as certified by the State Council of Higher Education for Virginia.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: The State Council of Higher Education for Virginia currently holds an annual orientation for new Board members. These annual programs could be expanded to include returning members, and the fiscal impacts of increases in facility space, event staffing, and program development are expected to be minimal. If the bill is interpreted to necessitate entirely new programming that could not be combined with existing orientations, the cost to SCHEV would be increased.
