4. Title: Governing boards of public institutions of higher education; increases in undergraduate tuition

5. Summary: Prohibits the governing board of any public institution of higher education from approving an increase in undergraduate tuition or mandatory fees without providing students and the public notice of the date, time, and location of the meeting at which public comment on such planned increase is permitted and provide an explanation of the need for the increase at least 10 days prior to such meeting. In addition, notice must be posted on the institution's website and through any other standard means of communication utilized by the institution with students.
