4. Title: Institutions of higher education; sexual violence policies; immunity from disciplinary action.

5. Summary: Requires each public institution of higher education, and each nonprofit private institution of higher education to include in its sexual violence policy a provision for immunity from disciplinary action for any enrolled student who commits a minor violation of the institution's code of conduct and who reports an act of sexual violence to the institution.

8. Fiscal Implications: The bill will require updates to sexual violence policies, but no fiscal impact is expected due to this requirement.
