**2. Patron:** Stanley

**3. Committee:** Passed both houses

**4. Title:** Sentence reductions; substantial assistance to prosecution.

**5. Summary:** Current law allows the court, upon motion of the attorney for the Commonwealth, to reduce a convicted person's sentence if the court determines such person provided substantial assistance in furthering the investigation or prosecution of another person engaged in certain crimes. This bill expands the list of crimes to include an act of grand larceny of a firearm, regardless of the firearm's value.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The proposed legislation could result in the need for fewer prison beds due to reductions in the sentences of persons convicted of felonies and sentenced to prison. However, because it is not possible to know how often and to what extent sentences would be reduced, the amount of bed-space reduction that might result cannot be projected.
