**5. Summary:** This bill redefines "relevant market area" for purposes of motorcycle franchises. The bill also removes the burden of proof from a motor vehicle dealer in a hearing related to a motorcycle franchise license.

Fiscal Implications:** This legislation shifts the burden of proof from motor vehicle dealers in a hearing related to a motorcycle franchise license to the manufacturer, factory branch, distributor, or distributor branch. This legislation is not anticipated to have a fiscal impact on either the Motor Vehicle Dealer Board or the Department of Motor Vehicles.
