4. Title: Property conveyance; Governor; Chickahominy Indian Tribe.

5. Summary: Authorizes the Governor to convey two parcels of land located in Charles City County comprising 216.57 acres and 10 acres to the Chickahominy Indian Tribe.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Yes, see Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill authorizes the Governor to purchase land in Charles City County and convey the land to the Chickahominy Indian Tribe. Any such purchase will require an additional appropriation of up to \$2.5 million.

The Office of the Attorney General and Department of Law indicates this bill has no fiscal impact to their agency, and preparing, executing, and delivering a deed to the Chickahominy Indian Tribe can be absorbed with existing resources.
