4. Title: Regulations governing housing of youth pursuant to federal government contracts

5. Summary: The proposed bill requires the Board of Juvenile Justice, in collaboration with the Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services, to promulgate regulations regarding the housing of youth who are detained in a juvenile correctional facility pursuant a contract with the federal government and not committed to such juvenile correctional facility by a court of the Commonwealth.

8. Fiscal Implications: The proposed bill requires Board of Juvenile Justice and the Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services to work collaboratively to establish regulations to govern the housing of youth who are detained in locally operated juvenile detention centers pursuant to federal government contracts, and not committed to such facility by a court of the Commonwealth.

According to the Department of Juvenile Justice and the Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services, the proposed bill is not expected to create a material fiscal impact on either agency.
