4. Title: High school graduation requirements

5. Summary: Requires the Board of Education, in establishing high school graduation requirements, to permit any student who is pursuing an advanced studies diploma and whose individualized education program specifies credit accommodation for world language to substitute two standard units of credit in computer science for two standard units of credit in a world language. For any student that elects to substitute a credit in computer science for credit in world language, his or her school counselor must provide notice to the student and parent or guardian of possible impacts related to college entrance requirements.
