3. Committee: Agriculture, Conservation and Natural Resources

4. Title: Special fishing permits for certain youth camps.

5. Summary: This bill authorizes employees of an organized nonprofit tax-exempt youth camp that holds a special fishing permit for certain youth camps to fish without a license in public waters adjacent to property owned by the camp. Current law only authorizes camp members under 18 years of age at such camp to fish without a license.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is anticipated that this bill will result in a nominal loss in revenue for the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries (DGIF).
