5. Summary: Directs the Department of Education to obtain a statewide learning management system for use in public schools by the start of the 2022-2023 school year.

Fiscal Implications: The Governor's introduced budget (HB/SB 30) includes \$7.1 million in FY 2021 and \$6.1 million in FY 2022 for the Department of Education to develop and implement a statewide learning management system for use in public schools. As such, there is no additional state fiscal impact resulting from the provisions of this bill.
