**3. Committee:** Passed both Houses.

**4. Title:** Virginia Health Club Act; automated external defibrillator required in health clubs.

**5. Summary:** Requires each health club location to have a working automated external defibrillator.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Final.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The fiscal impact of this bill on the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services (VDACS) is indeterminate. The agency does not currently conduct onsite inspections to ensure compliance with the Virginia Health Club Act. If the agency is required to conduct inspections, additional resources may be required. Many health clubs are exempt from the Act and the total number of health clubs in Virginia is unknown; as such, it is not possible to determine the exact resources that will be required. Administration of the Virginia Health Club Act is a nongeneral fund supported program.
