**4. Title:** Annual reporting requirements for public institutions of higher education and foundations

**5. Summary:** Requires public institutions of higher education and associated foundations to report annually on the following: total annual expenditures by each foundation; percentage of expenditures used for scholarships or financial aid by each foundation; percentage of expenditures used for instructional programs by each foundation; percentage of expenditures used for research by each foundation; percentage of expenditures used for intercollegiate athletics by each foundation; and percentage of expenditures used for buildings and maintenance by each foundation.
