4. Title: Licensed family day homes; storage of firearms.

5. Summary: Requires that all firearms in a licensed family day home be stored unloaded in a locked container, compartment, or cabinet. The bill also requires that, during the family day home's hours of operation, ammunition be stored separate from all firearms in a locked container, compartment, or cabinet.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: None.

8. Fiscal Implications: This legislation will not expand the Department's legal authority or service population. Likewise, it will not impact the Department's programs or services. Similar regulations already exist regarding storage of firearms and ammunition in family day homes regulated by the Department of Social Services.
