3. Committee: House Public Safety

4. Title: Licensed family day homes; storage of firearms.

5. Summary: Requires that during the hours of operation of a family day home, all firearms be stored unloaded in a locked container, compartment, or cabinet and that ammunition be stored in a separate locked container, compartment, or cabinet.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: None.

8. Fiscal Implications: This legislation will not expand the Department's legal authority or service population. Likewise, it will not impact the Department's programs or services. Similar regulations already exist regarding storage of firearms and ammunition in family day homes regulated by the Department of Social Services.
