3. Committee: Passed both Houses.

4. Title: Board of Health; certificate of birth; change of sex.

5. Summary: Requires the State Registrar to establish a new certificate of birth for a person born in the Commonwealth upon receipt of a request by a person to show a change of sex of the person and, if a person provides a certified copy of a court order changing the person's name, to show a new name on the certificate of birth. The bill requires the person requesting such new certificate of birth to submit a form furnished by the state registrar and completed by a health care provider from whom the person has received treatment stating that the person has undergone clinically appropriate treatment for gender transition. The bill eliminates the current requirement for the receipt of a certified copy of a court order indicating that the sex of the person has been changed by medical procedure.
