4. Title: Voter registration; notification of denial.

5. Summary: Requires notice of a denial of an application for voter registration to be provided by the general registrar to the applicant within five days of the denial. Voter registration applications shall request the applicant provide his telephone number and email address; however, no application shall be denied for failure to provide such information. Notices of application denial shall be given in writing and by email or telephone if such information was provided. If the general registrar is able to reach the applicant by telephone, corrections may be made by the applicant by telephone. The bill contains technical amendments.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: No state fiscal impact.

8. Fiscal Implications: The proposed legislation is not expected to have a state fiscal impact.

Any potential impact to local general registrars is indeterminate.
