4. Title: Outpatient treatment related to competency to stand trial

Summary: The proposed bill clarifies that for the purposes of restorative treatment for a person incompetent but restorable to stand trial that outpatient treatment may occur in a local correctional facility or at a location determined by the appropriate community services board or behavioral health authority.
