**4. Title:** Electric personal delivery devices.

**5. Summary:** Makes several changes related to electric personal delivery devices, including changing the term used to refer to such devices to "personal delivery devices" and changing the weight limit of such devices from 50 to 500 pounds. The bill authorizes personal delivery devices to operate on any sidewalk or crosswalk, or if a sidewalk or crosswalk is not available, the side of any roadway with a speed limit of 25 miles or less. The bill also requires any personal delivery device transporting hazardous materials to comply with the federal Hazardous Materials Transportation Act.
