1.	Title:	Stormwater and erosion and sediment control; acceptance of plans in lieu of plan review.
5.	Summary: Authorizes the State Water Control Board or the Department of Environmental Quality, in its administration of a Virginia Stormwater Management Program, Virginia Erosion and Stormwater Management Program, or Virginia Erosion and Sediment Control Program, to choose to accept a set of plans and supporting calculations for any land-disturbing activity determined to be de minimus using a risk-based approach established by the Board. The bill provides that such plans and supporting calculations shall satisfy the requirement that the Board or the Department retain a certified plan reviewer or conduct a plan review. The bill also directs the Board to adopt implementing regulations and provides requirements for the process of adoption.

3.	Fiscal Implications: The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) can develop risk-based plan review criteria for its Stormwater Management, Erosion and Stormwater Management, and Erosion and Sediment Control programs using existing resources. DEQ currently employs eight full-time plan reviewers for stormwater and sediment control. After development of the risk-based criteria as described in this bill, DEQ anticipates an indeterminate reduction in plan review workload which will allow the agency to shift program capacity to high-priority projects in order to ensure completion within the statutory and regulatory timeframes.
