4. Title: Commission on School Construction and Modernization established; report.

5. Summary: The enrolled bill establishes the Commission on School Construction and Modernization for the purpose of providing guidance and resources to local school divisions related to school construction and modernization and making funding recommendations to the General Assembly and the Governor. The bill has a sunset date of July 1, 2026, with a provision that if the Commission does not receive funding in the appropriation act after its first year, it will sunset on July 1 of the following year.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Senate of Virginia estimates the engrossed bill presents an annual impact of \$3,600 to pay the interim meeting compensation for the three Senate members. The House of Delegates estimates an annual impact of \$6,000 to pay the interim meeting compensation for the 5 House members. It is estimated the Commission would incur an annual cost up to \$20,000 to cover staffing and administrative expenses, as well as the compensation of citizen members and the reimbursement of reasonable and necessary expenses of all members.
