**2. Patron:** Hashmi

**3. Committee:** Transportation

**4. Title:** Parking of vehicles; electric vehicle charging spots; civil penalties.

**5. Summary:** Prohibits a person from parking a vehicle not capable of receiving an electric charge in a space reserved for charging electric vehicles. A violation is subject to a civil penalty of \$500, and the vehicle may be towed or impounded. The bill also allows localities to create a similar local ordinance.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The implementation of this bill would result in more individuals being subject to a civil penalty of \$500. Any proceeds collected from such penalties will be deposited either into the state's Literary Fund or to a locality. At this time, it is not possible to determine the likely increase in revenue that could be generated as a result of this bill.
