A *BILL to amend and reenact § 9.1-112 of the Code of Virginia, relating to Criminal Justices Services Board; Committee on Training.*

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 9.1-112 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 9.1-112. Committee on Training; membership.

A. There is created a permanent Committee on Training under the Board that shall be the policy-making body responsible to the Board for effecting the provisions of subdivisions 2 through 17 of § 9.1-102. The Committee on Training shall be composed of 15 members of the Board as follows: the Superintendent of the Department of State Police; the Director of the Department of Corrections; a member of the Private Security Services Advisory Board; the Executive Secretary of the Supreme Court of Virginia; ~~two sheriffs~~ *one sheriff* representing the Virginia State Sheriffs' Association; ~~two representatives~~ *one representative* of the Virginia Association of Chiefs of Police Association; the active-duty law-enforcement officer representing police and fraternal associations; the attorney for the Commonwealth representing the Virginia Association of Commonwealth's Attorneys; *an attorney representing the Virginia Indigent Defense Commission*; a representative of the Virginia Municipal League; a representative of the Virginia Association of Counties; *an attorney representing civil liberty groups; one mental health provider*; a regional jail superintendent representing the Virginia Association of Regional Jails; *and one citizen representing community interests of minority individuals from one of the four groups defined in subsection F of § 2.2-4310; and one member designated by the chairman of the Board from among the other appointments made by the Governor.*

B. The Committee on Training shall annually elect its chairman from among its members.
