2. Patron: Carroll Foy

3. Committee: Passed both houses.

4. Title: Law-enforcement officers; prohibition on the use of neck restraints; penalty.

5. Summary: Provides that the use of a neck restraint by a law enforcement officer is prohibited unless such use is immediately necessary to protect the officer or another person. In addition to any other penalty authorized by law, any officer who knowingly violates this section shall be subject to disciplinary action, including dismissal, demotion, suspension, or transfer of the officer, or decertification as provided elsewhere in the Code.

8. Fiscal Implications: The proposed legislation is not expected to have a fiscal impact on state agencies. Any potential fiscal impact on local law enforcement agencies is indeterminate at this time.
