3. Committee: Courts of Justice

4. Title: Supplement to the Sex Offender and Crimes Against Minors Registry.

5. Summary: Provides that the Supplement to the Sex Offender and Crimes against Minors Registry shall include information on persons who were convicted of certain sexual offenses on or after July 1, 1970, and before July 1, 1994 who are not currently on the Registry. Under current law, the Supplement includes information on persons who were convicted on or after July 1, 1980 and before July 1, 1994.

Fiscal Implications: The Department of State Police (VSP) is responsible for administering the Sex Offender Registry, performing checks on registered offenders, and investigating potential violations.
