Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 11

1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Article 1 of Chapter 1 of Title 9.1 a section 12 13 numbered 9.1-116.7 as follows:

§ 9.1-116.7. Virginia Law Enforcement Professional Standards Commission Accreditation Grant 14 15 Fund and Program.

A. There is hereby created in the state treasury a special nonreverting fund to be known as the 16 Virginia Law Enforcement Professional Standards Commission Accreditation Grant Fund, hereinafter 17 referred to as "the Fund." The Fund shall be established on the books of the Comptroller. All funds 18 19 appropriated for such purpose and any gifts, donations, grants, bequests, and other funds received on its 20 behalf shall be paid into the state treasury and credited to the Fund. Interest earned on moneys in the 21 Fund shall remain in the Fund and be credited to it. Any moneys remaining in the Fund, including 22 interest thereon, at the end of each fiscal year shall not revert to the general fund but shall remain in 23 the Fund. Moneys in the Fund shall be used solely for purposes of (i) awarding grants on a competitive 24 basis through the Virginia Law Enforcement Professional Standards Commission Accreditation Grant 25 Program established pursuant to subsection B or (ii) implementing and administering the Virginia Law 26 Enforcement Professional Standards Commission Accreditation Grant Program. Expenditures and 27 disbursements from the Fund shall be made by the State Treasurer on warrants issued by the 28 Comptroller upon written request signed by the Director of the Department. 29 B. The Virginia Law Enforcement Professional Standards Commission Accreditation Grant Program,

hereinafter referred to as "the Program," is hereby established for the purpose of awarding grants on a 30 competitive basis from such funds as may be available from the Fund to law-enforcement agencies to 31 pursue accreditation by the Virginia Law Enforcement Professional Standards Commission. The 32 33 Program shall be administered by the Department. In administering the Program, the Department shall 34 establish and publish guidelines and criteria for grant awards, including guidelines and criteria 35 governing agreements between the Department and grant recipients. The Department shall oversee each grant awarded through the Program and ensure thorough reporting on each such grant. 36
