21103327D 1 HOUSE BILL NO. 2069 2 AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE 3 (Proposed by the House Committee on Transportation 4 on January 21, 2021) 5 (Patrons Prior to Substitute—Delegates McOuinn and Walker [HB 1797]) A BILL to amend and reenact §§ 46.2-742.2, 46.2-745.1, and 46.2-745.2 of the Code of Virginia and to 6 7 amend the Code of Virginia by adding sections numbered 46.2-725.3, 46.2-745.4, and 46.2-745.5, 8 relating to special license plates; military decorations. 9 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 1. That §§ 46.2-742.2, 46.2-745.1, and 46.2-745.2 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted and that the Code of Virginia is amended by adding sections numbered 46.2-725.3, 10 11 46.2-745.4, and 46.2-745.5 as follows: 12 § 46.2-725.3. Special license plates for recipients of certain military decorations. 13 14 A. No special license plate for recipients of a military decoration shall be considered by the General 15 Assembly unless and until the person or entity seeking the authorization of such special plate has demonstrated to the satisfaction of the General Assembly the order of precedence of such military 16 17 decoration as determined by the federal Department of Defense or other relevant federal agency. B. Any special license plate for recipients of a military decoration falling below the Medal of Honor 18 and above the Purple Heart in order of precedence shall be authorized for issuance by the Department 19 20 with a \$10 one-time fee in addition to the prescribed cost of state license plates. Any special license plate for recipients of a military decoration falling below the Purple Heart in the order of precedence 21 shall be authorized for issuance by the Department with a \$10 annual special license plate fee in 22 23 addition to the prescribed cost of state license plates. Special license plates for recipients of the Purple Heart shall be issued as provided in § 46.2-742. The Department is authorized to issue an additional 24 25 plate reflecting the "V" for Valor for any plate that the federal Department of Defense or other relevant federal agency has determined is eligible for the "V" for Valor Device. 26 C. Notwithstanding § 46.2-725, special license plates for the recipients of a military decoration are 27 28 exempt from subdivisions B 1 and 2 of § 46.2-725. Unremarried surviving spouses of individuals eligible 29 to receive such special license plates are also authorized to receive such special license plates. 30 § 46.2-742.2. Special license plates for persons awarded the Navy Cross, the Distinguished Service Cross, the Air Force Cross, the Distinguished Flying Cross, or the Distinguished Flying 31 Cross with a "V" for Valor. 32 33 On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant has been awarded the Navy 34 Cross, the Distinguished Service Cross, the Air Force Cross, or the Distinguished Flying Cross, or the 35 Distinguished Flying Cross with a "V" for Valor, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special 36 license plates. 37 The provisions of subdivisions B 1 and 2 of subsection B of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license 38 plates issued under this section. 39 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section 40 may also be issued special license plates under this section. 41 The design of license plates issued under this section to persons who have been awarded multiple 42 decorations shall reflect the number of such decorations. For each set of license plates issued under this section the Commissioner shall charge, in addition to 43 44 the prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of \$10 at the time the plates are issued. § 46.2-745.1. Special license plates for persons awarded the Navy and Marine Corps Medal, the 45 Airman's Medal, the Army Soldier's Medal, or the Coast Guard Medal. 46 47 On receipt of an application and written confirmation from one of the armed services of the United States that the applicant has been awarded the Navy and Marine Corps Medal, the Airman's Medal, the **48** Army Soldier's Medal, or the Coast Guard Medal, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to 49 such persons. No fee shall be charged for the issuance of these license plates under this section to any 50 51 one motor vehicle owned and used personally by any applicant. For each additional set of license plates issued to an applicant under this section, the Commissioner shall charge the prescribed fee for state 52 53 license plates. For each set of license plates issued under this section, the Commissioner shall charge, in 54 addition to the prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of \$10 at the time the plates are 55 issued. 56 It shall be unlawful for any person who is not a person described in this section to willfully and 57 falsely represent himself as having the qualifications to obtain the special license plates herein provided 58 for. 59

63 § 46.2-745.2. Special license plates for persons awarded the Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal.
 64 On receipt of an application and written confirmation from one of the armed services that the
 65 applicant has been awarded the Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, the Commissioner shall issue
 66 special license plates to such persons and to unremarried surviving spouses of such persons.

67 For each set of plates issued under this section, the Commissioner shall charge, in addition to the prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time an annual fee of \$10 at the time the plates are issued.

69 It shall be unlawful for any person who is not a person described in this section to willfully and
 70 falsely represent himself as having the qualifications to obtain the special license plates herein provided
 71 for.

The provisions of subdivisions B 1 and 2 of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license plates issued under this section.

74 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section75 may also be issued special license plates under this section.

§ 46.2-745.4. Special license plates for persons awarded the Distinguished Service Medal, the Navy
 Distinguished Service Medal, the Marine Corps Distinguished Service Medal, or the Air Force
 Distinguished Service Medal.

79 On receipt of an application and written confirmation from one of the armed services that the 80 applicant has been awarded the Distinguished Service Medal, the Navy Distinguished Service Medal, the 81 Marine Corps Distinguished Service Medal, or the Air Force Distinguished Service Medal, the 82 Commissioner shall issue special license plates to such persons.

83 For each set of plates issued under this section, the Commissioner shall charge, in addition to the 84 prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of \$10 at the time the plates are issued.

85 It shall be unlawful for any person who is not a person described in this section to willfully and
86 falsely represent himself as having the qualifications to obtain the special license plates herein provided
87 for.

88 The provisions of subdivisions B 1 and 2 of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license plates issued under this section.

90 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section91 may also be issued special license plates under this section.

92 § 46.2-745.5. Special license plates for persons awarded the Defense Distinguished Service Medal
 93 or the Defense Superior Service Medal.

94 On receipt of an application and written confirmation from one of the armed services that the
95 applicant has been awarded the Defense Distinguished Service Medal or the Defense Superior Service
96 Medal, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to such persons.

97 For each set of plates issued under this section, the Commissioner shall charge, in addition to the 98 prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of \$10 at the time the plates are issued.

99 It shall be unlawful for any person who is not a person described in this section to willfully and falsely represent himself as having the qualifications to obtain the special license plates herein provided for.

102 The provisions of subdivisions B 1 and 2 of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license plates issued under **103** this section.

104 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section105 may also be issued special license plates under this section.

106 2. That all license plates issued pursuant to § 46.2-745.1 or 46.2-745.2 of the Code of Virginia prior

107 to July 1, 2021, shall remain valid until their expiration and shall be renewed under the provisions

108 of § 46.2-745.1 or 46.2-745.2 of the Code of Virginia as they existed prior to July 1, 2021.
