6	Requesting the Department of Rail and Public Transportation to study transit equity and modernization
7	in the Commonwealth. Report.
8	WHEREAS, public transit is vital for the equitable growth of the Commonwealth's economy,
9	transportation infrastructure, and sustainability efforts; and
10	WHEREAS, people across the Commonwealth rely on public transit to reach employment
11	opportunities, socialize with friends and family, connect with their communities, and meaningfully
12	participate in our society; and
13	WHEREAS, many transportation systems in the Commonwealth lack the necessary infrastructure to
14	provide essential public transit needs; and
15	WHEREAS, in order to make public transit in the Commonwealth a world-class transportation
16 17	system, we must analyze equity issues as we focus on improvements, increased efficiency, and
17	modernization; now, therefore, be it RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the Department of Rail and
10 19	Public Transportation be requested to study transit equity and modernization in the Commonwealth.
20	In conducting its study, the Department of Rail and Public Transportation shall complete a needs
21	assessment focusing on the equitable delivery of transportation services and modernization of transit in
$\overline{22}$	the Commonwealth. The Department of Rail and Public Transportation, with the cooperation of all
23	transit agencies that receive funding pursuant to subdivision D 1 of § 33.2-1526.1 of the Code of
24	Virginia, shall study of transit accessibility, adequacy of transit infrastructure, transit electrification,
25	implementation of emerging technology, transit safety, and transit system engagement. The Department
26	of Rail and Public Transportation shall place particular emphasis on transit services and engagement
27	opportunities for underserved and underrepresented communities.
28	All agencies of the Commonwealth shall provide assistance to the Department of Rail and Public
29	Transportation for this study, upon request.
30	The Director of the Department of Rail and Public Transportation shall submit to the Governor and
31	the General Assembly an interim report containing an executive summary of its activity and work no
32	later than December 1, 2021, and a final report containing an executive summary of its activities and
33	recommendations no later than August 1, 2022. Such reports shall be submitted for publication as a report document as provided in the procedures of the Division of Legislative Automated Systems for the

33	processing of legislative documents and reports and shall be posted on the General Assembly's website.

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
