10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Title 3.2 a chapter numbered 47.1,
12	consisting of sections numbered 3.2-4780 through 3.2-4783, as follows:
13	CHAPTER 47.1.
14	VIRGINIA AGRICULTURE FOOD ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.
15	§ 3.2-4780. Definitions.
16	As used in this chapter, unless the context requires a different meaning:
17	"Charitable food assistance organization" means an organization operating in Virginia that provides
18	nutrition assistance to relieve situations of emergency and distress through the provision of food to
19	needy persons in Virginia.
20	"Fund" means the Virginia Agriculture Food Assistance Fund.
21	"VAFA Program" means the Virginia Agriculture Food Assistance Program.
22 23	§ 3.2-4781. Virginia Agriculture Food Assistance Fund.
23 24	There is hereby created in the state treasury a special nonreverting fund to be known as the Virginia Agriculture Food Assistance Fund, referred to in this section as "the Fund." The Fund shall be
2 <b>4</b> 25	established on the books of the Comptroller. All funds appropriated for such purpose and any gifts,
<b>2</b> 6	donations, grants, bequests, and other funds received on its behalf shall be paid into the state treasury
27	and credited to the Fund. Interest earned on moneys in the Fund shall remain in the Fund and be
28	credited to it. Any moneys remaining in the Fund, including interest thereon, at the end of each fiscal
29	year shall not revert to the general fund but shall remain in the Fund. Moneys in the Fund shall be
30	used solely for the purposes of carrying out the provisions of this chapter. Expenditures and
31	disbursements from the Fund shall be made by the State Treasurer on warrants issued by the
32	Comptroller upon written request signed by the Commissioner.
33	§ 3.2-4782. Authority of Commissioner.
34	A. The Commissioner shall establish the Virginia Agriculture Food Assistance Program (VAFA
35	Program) for Virginia farmers and food producers to donate, sell, or otherwise provide agriculture
36	products to charitable food assistance organizations.
37	B. The Commissioner may contract with charitable food assistance organizations operating in
38 39	Virginia or regional charitable food assistance organizations to carry out the provisions of this chapter.
<b>40</b>	C. The Commissioner shall provide grants from the Fund to charitable food assistance organizations to reimburse farmers or food producers for any costs associated with harvesting, processing, packaging,
<b>4</b> 0 <b>4</b> 1	or transporting agriculture products donated, sold, or otherwise provided to such charitable food
42	assistance organizations.
43	D. The Commissioner may develop guidelines and adopt regulations to carry out the provisions of
44	this chapter. [Such regulations shall prohibit any charitable food assistance organization that contracts
45	with or receives a grant from the Commissioner from attributing more than five percent of the total
46	grant or contract amount to administrative costs.
47	§ 3.2-4783. Virginia Agriculture Food Assistance Program.
<b>48</b>	The VAFA Program shall:
49	1. Provide grants from the Fund to charitable food assistance organizations to reimburse farmers or
50	food producers for any costs associated with harvesting, processing, packaging, or transporting
51	agriculture products donated to such charitable food assistance organizations; and
52	2. Distribute agriculture products to needy persons in Virginia in accordance with the food
53	distribution guidelines for each charitable food assistance organization.
