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10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 22.1-7.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 22.1-7.1. Open school enrollment policy.
13	A. Any local school board may establish and implement policies to provide for the open enrollment
14 15	to any school of any student residing within the school division upon the request of a parent or
15 16	guardian. All local school boards shall establish and implement policies to provide for the open enrollment to any school of any student who is eligible to receive free or reduced lunch upon the
17	request of a parent or guardian. In developing such policies, a local school board may include the
18	following conditions and limitations:
19	1. An application process whereby a parent or guardian indicates a school preference for purposes of
20	his child attending a school in the child's school division but outside of the attendance area in which the
21	child resides;
22	2. A requirement that the parent or guardian provide transportation for the student attending a school
23	other than his assigned school;
24	3. A requirement that a student may be disqualified from attending a school other than his assigned
25	school if he has been subject to a specified disciplinary action;
26	4. A prohibition on the recruitment of a student from one school to another by a school division
27	employee;
28 29	5. A limitation on participation in certain athletic activities for a student who chooses to attend a school other than his assigned school;
<u>30</u>	6. A random, unbiased selection process in the event <i>that</i> open enrollment requests exceed the
31	capacity of a school;
32	7. A provision that a student shall be permitted to remain at the receiving school until the student
33	has completed the highest grade level in the school; and
34	8. A preference to a student (i) who resides in a location that has been subject to a change in school
35	attendance area during the previous two years, (ii) who has a sibling attending the receiving school, or
36	(iii) whose parent or guardian is an employee of the receiving school.
37	B. A copy of the school division's policies for open enrollment, if any, shall be posted on the
38	division's website and shall be available to the public upon request.
39 40	C. Nothing in this section shall interfere with a local school board's authority to adopt a pupil
40 41	placement plan pursuant to § 22.1-79. D. For the purposes of this section, "open enrollment" means a policy adopted and implemented by a
42	local school board to allow any student to enroll in any school within the school division of attendance
43	regardless of the location of the student's residence.
