10	RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, a majority of the members elected to
11 12	each house agreeing, That the following amendment to the Constitution of Virginia be, and the same hereby is, proposed and referred to the General Assembly at its first regular session held after the next
12	general election of members of the House of Delegates for its concurrence in conformity with the
13 14	provisions of Section 1 of Article XII of the Constitution of Virginia, namely:
15	Amend Section 9 of Article IV of the Constitution of Virginia as follows:
16	ARTICLE IV
17	LEGISLATURE
18	Section 9. Immunity of legislators.
19	Members of the General Assembly shall, in all cases except treason, felony, or breach of the peace
20	except upon issuance of process for arrest by a judge with authorization of the attorney for the
21	Commonwealth or the law-enforcement agency having jurisdiction over the offense, be privileged from
22	arrest during the sessions of their respective houses; and for any speech or debate in either house shall
23	not be questioned in any other place. They shall not be subject to arrest under any civil process during
24	the sessions of the General Assembly, or during the fifteen days before the beginning or after the ending
