5.	Summary: Increases the maximum allowable amount for a single bingo door prize from \$50 to \$250 and the maximum allowable cumulative door prizes in any one bingo session from \$250 to \$500. The bill also increases the maximum allowable regular bingo or special bingo game prize from \$100 to \$200 and the prize for a single instant bingo, pull tab, or seal card from \$1,000 to \$2,000. The bill increases the maximum allowable prize for a bingo jackpot from \$1,000 to \$2,000 and the total allowable amount of bingo jackpot prizes awarded in any one session from \$1,000 to \$2,000. Finally, the bill increases from \$100 to \$200 the allowable amount of increase of a progressive prize per session in certain progressive bingo games. The bill satisfies the reenactment requirement of Chapter 980 of the Acts of Assembly of 2020.
