**4. Title:** Motor vehicles used for the delivery of property; trade dress.

**5. Summary:** This bill requires motor vehicles used for the delivery of property to the purchaser to display a logo, insignia, or emblem identifying the person or entity with which the driver of the vehicle is associated during the delivery.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Preliminary. See Item #8.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** No fiscal impact is anticipated from this legislation. The bill would require personal vehicles that carry property for hire to display a window decal or other identifier similar to the trade dress displayed by transportation network companies (TNC) partners. There are programs allowing individuals to use their personal vehicles to provide delivery services for major retailers. One example is the Amazon Flex program which allows individuals to create an account and deliver items for Amazon using their personal vehicles. There is currently no requirement that these vehicles display trade dress while engaged in the delivery service.
